

Family Home Evening Lesson:

My Testimony Tree

Opening Song: *Faith* (Children's Songbook, pg 96)

Prayer:

Opening Activity: Hold up a little seed (anything will do—a corn kernel, a pea, a bean, a nut, etc). Ask children, “What can this seed become?” “How can something so tiny become something so big?” “Does it grow and change in just one day?” Discuss how a testimony is the same—it starts small, but with daily care, it can grow into something great.

Scriptures: Alma 32:28, John 7:17, and/or James 1:5-6

Read: *My Testimony Tree*

Application Activities:

- Plant some seeds in indoor pots or a garden outside. Care for them as a family and talk about how each step reminds us about the things we need to do to care for our testimony trees.
- Draw pictures of one or more things you can do this week to help nourish and feed your testimony tree. Next week, report on the things you did to feed your testimony tree and how you feel about it.
